On 13th June 2017, as part of London Creativity and Wellbeing Week, you are invited to join ACAVA in celebrating the achievements of the group, and view some of the


artwork created throughout the programme.

Did you know?

It is now against the law for taxi and private hire drivers with wheelchair accessible vehicles to refuse wheelchair users, or charge them more.

Drivers can be fined up to £1,000 under the Equality Act 2010, their licence suspended or revoked, and prosecuted by Transport for London for discrimination.
