## Campaign to Tackle Disability Discrimination on Public Transport

**The Disability Justice Project, which uses the law to challenge disability discrimination against deaf and disabled people, has launched the #TransportJustice campaign.**

They are raising money through a crowd funding appeal to fund and organise support to enable Disabled people to bring court cases about discrimination on public transport. The fund will enable people to get legal advice and representation in cases which have the potential to change policy or practice.

### *The Disability Justice Project say:*

It is left to Disabled people to enforce our rights under the Equality Act 2010 and we know how difficult and risky it is for many of us to take public transport providers to court.

We know what we set out to do is not easy and any support that you can give us will make a huge difference.

- Encourage your colleagues, members and


supporters to take part in the social media campaign by sharing their experience of traveling on public transport using hashtag #TransportJustice.


## Simone's Farewell

### Breathing Techniques, Meditation and Self-Confidence:


A course designed to develop these techniques for some of the most isolated local adult disabled learners. Working with a local trainer, already experienced and adept at supporting local disabled people in this area
