Fruit bread and butter pudding

A warm and comforting recipe from Jean as the seasons change...

You will need:

7 slices of fruit bread, liahtly buttered and cut in half 2 cups of milk 30g caster sugar 2 eggs and a pinch of nutmeg.

Method:

Pre-heat the oven for 180C. 350F, or gas mark 4. Grease a baking dish and arrange the sliced fruit bread in the dish. Mix eggs, milk, sugar and whisk well, pour over the fruit bread and sprinkle with nutmea. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes or until brown on top.



Eat with custard or pouring cream. Enjoy!
